The CTS is located between Zoologischer Garten and Ernst-Reuter-Platz, in Hardenbergstraße 16-18 (former Chamber of Commerce building). So the CTS is situated centrally in Berlin's City-West and can be easily reached by public transport and by car. The building's entrance is directly in Hardenbergstraße. The CTS's premises are on the 4th, 5th and 6th floor.

By public transport

One possibility passes by *Zoologischer Garten*. Leave the station towards Jebensstraße, turn to the left and cross Hardenbergstraße. Then to the right, keep on walking for about 100 metres until you get to Hardenbergstraße 16-18. Another possibility passes by *Ernst-Reuter-Platz*. From the metro station it is a walkway of approximately 650 metres, alongside Hardenbergstraße. It is also possible to catch buses M45 and 245 (both direction S+U Zoologischer Garten) to the stop Jebensstraße.

Station Zoologischer Garten, line 2 (red line) and line 9 (orange line)

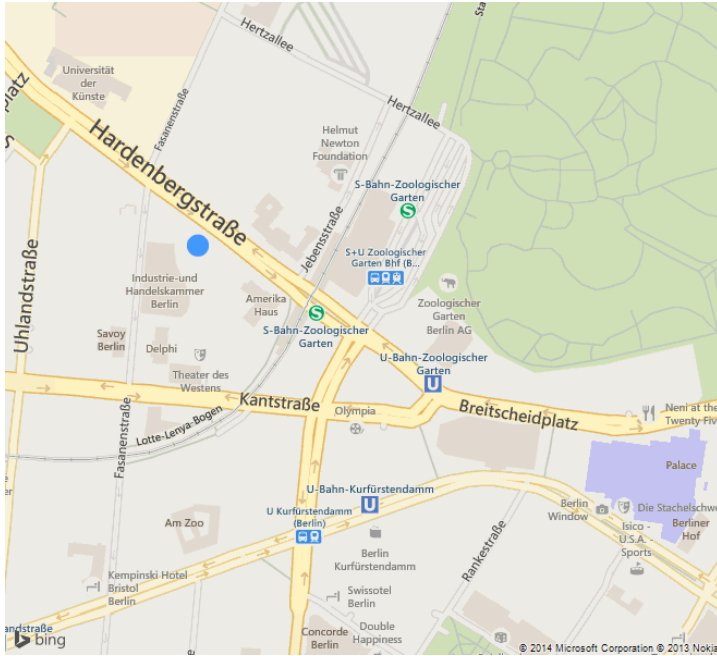
Station Ernst-Reuter-Platz, line 2 (red line)
